C. or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Twenty-eight and 38/100llars (\$ 28.38 ), commencing on the first day of November, 19 39, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of October, 19 59

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the south side of West Tallulah Drive near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 on plat of property of H. L. S. Investment Company made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1937, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book D, page 225, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by A. Newton Stall August 31, 1939, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

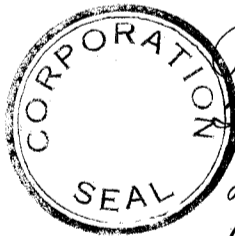
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of West Tallulah Drive, joint corner of Lots 6 and 7, said pin also being 265 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of West Tallulah Drive and Augusta Road; and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6 S. 27-45 E. 195 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-30 W. 54 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 N. 31-00 W. 194.2 feet to an iron pin on the south side of West Tallulah Drive; thence with the south side of said Drive N. 55-50 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
