in and by my J. G. Blair certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am with and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Nine Hundred & No/100

( \$ 900.00 ) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of THIRTEEN & NO/100

( \$ 13.00 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, on the Northeast side of Judson Road, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 2 on plat of Property of G. C. Richardson made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in January, 1939, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Judson Road, at the corner of Lot No. 1, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 34-52 E. 185 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-43 E. 55 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of said lot, S. 34-52 W. 185 feet to an iron pin on Judson Road; thence with the Northeastern side of Judson Road, N. 53-43 W. 55 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to J.
