SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said D. Townsend Smith, Jr.  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am  
well and truly indebted to S. E. Colvin, Jr., Committee for Herbert L. Thruston

in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred and 00/100  
(\$700.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid  
semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid in Greenville Township, about two miles West of Greenville County Court House, in a section known as City View, and being known and designated as Lot No. 78 of Section B as shown by blue print made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, and of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 460 and 461 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pin on the West side of Henderson Street, 100 feet from the corner of O'Neal Street, and running thence N. 89-30 W. 150 feet to a pin on a ten foot alley; thence with said alley N. 00-30 E. 50 feet to a point; thence S. 89-30 E. 150 feet to a point on Henderson Street; thence with said Henderson Street S. 00-30 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning."
