all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

About two miles from Greenville County Court House and described by metes and bounds, as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Parker Road 81.26 feet from the point of intersection of the said Southwest line of said Parker Road with the South line of City View Street and running thence S. 37 E. running with the Southwest line of Parker Road, 80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82 3/4 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 7 1/4 W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 62 E. 110 feet to the Southwest line of Parker Road, the point of beginning.
