Whereas, I the said Delphina Wilkerson

in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am

in the full and just sum of Three Hundred & No/100

(\$ 300) Dollars to be paid in twelve monthly installments of  
\$25.00 each beginning July 1, 1940 and ending June 1, 1941

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid
