All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the South side of Woodfin Avenue (formerly McKay Street) in the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, being shown and delineated as Lot 2, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C, Page 200, being bounded on the North by Woodfin Avenue (formerly McKay Street), on the East by lot now or formerly owned by W. D. Parrish and T. C. Gower, on the South by Wilkins Street, and on the West by Lot 3, the property of Edgar S. Barry; said lot having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

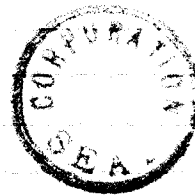
