TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, A. Milton Stephens SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said A. Milton Stephens

in and by MY certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am
well and truly indebted to R. K. Taylor

in the full and just sum of TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED AND NO 100
(\$2,500.00) Dollars, to be paid sixty (60) days after date

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid
quarterly

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note of this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

R. K. Taylor his heirs and assigns:-

All those two certain lots or units of land near the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northeast side of Brookway Drive, being known and designated as units Nos. 25 and 26, Block C, as shown on a revised plat of Grove Park made by W. J. Riddle, April, 1939, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, pages 68 and 69, reference to which plat is hereby made for a more complete description.

For value received I hereby assign, transfer and set over to The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S.C. with recourse the within mortgage and the note it secures this the 14th day of August, 1940. at Greenville, S.C.
