All of that parcel or tract of land in Chick Springs Township, State and County aforesaid, containing 2.25 acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands of R. A. Ford; on the East by lands of T. B. Bramlett; on the South by lands of T. B. Bramlett and Mrs. E. T. Westmoreland and on the West by lands of Mrs. E. T. Westmoreland, and having the following courses and distances according to a survey and map of H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated November 25, 1939, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of private road leading from the Buncombe Road to the residence of T. B. Bramlett, the Western corner of said tract, and runs thence along the edge of said private road S 71-10 E. 434 feet to an iron pin, West of the intersection of said private road with the Gilreath Mill Road; thence N 21-48 E. 455.6 feet to an iron pin West of the said Gilreath Mill Road; thence S 64-00 W 645.5 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by T.
