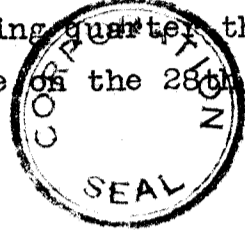

all that tract or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the road that
leads from Col. Lynch's to Spartanburg half-mile East of S. Powells, in Greenville County,
State of South Carolina.

Beginning on a rock near the road thence N. 62½ E. 6.60 chs. to a stake old line;
thence N. 6½ W. 2.18 to a stake or rock; thence S. 89½ W. 6.80 to a hickory and rock; thence
S. 13 E. 5.31 to the beginning, containing two and one half (2½) acres, more or less.
This being the same property conveyed to Enoree Baptist Church by Hugh Bishop by deed
