Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of Rogers Avenue, corner of Lot No. 8, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 10-17 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79-28 W. 69.8 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 6; thence S. 8-36 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Rogers Avenue; thence with the Northern side of Rogers Avenue, N. 79-28 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to W. D. Bishop by Hext M. Perry, Trustee, by deed dated December 29, 1937, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds 226 at page 319.
