constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and in
Greenville Township, about one and one-half miles from the City of Greenville on the North side
of Henry Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 66 of a subdivision known as
Oakwood, and having, according to Plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book "A" page 424, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
