with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jean M. Davis

All that tract of land in School District No. 4-F, Pepper, Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing fourteen acres, more or less, lying on the west side of Grove Creek, waters of Saluda River, and having the following metes and bounds:  
BEGINNING in the center (on the upstream side) of bridge across Grove Creek, thence S. 74 1/2 W. 7.83 with road to rock x3 on south side of road; thence S. 40 1/2 E. 1.15 to rock x3; thence due south 17.58 to bridge on the Garrison McKenzie branch; thence down to the meanders of said branch 5.80 chains to center of Grove Creek; thence up the meanders of said creek (about) 22.25 chs. to the beginning corner, in the bridge; bounded on the north by lands of Jas. E. Richey; on the south by lands of J. H. Charles; on the west by lands of C. W. Mitchell; and east by Grove creek; Being the same property conveyed to me by Joe Baty by deed dated May 20, 1941, said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.
