WHEREAS I, the said *Paid* R. H. Craig

in and by *my* certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents *am* well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

Three thousand and no/100
THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$3,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of *26.00* Dollars upon the first

Twenty-six and no/100
TWENTY-SIX AND NO/100

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or in legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *John* R. H. Craig

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said *R. H. Craig*

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Butler Township, on the north side of Wickliffe street, now known as Eastlan Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5, of Block E, of a subdivision known as Carolina Court, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", at page 96, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Eastlan Drive (formerly Wickliffe street), at the joint corner of Lots 5 and 6, of Block E, which point is 350 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of Wickliffe street and Montevista avenue, and running thence with the line of Wickliffe street, N. 54-55 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 4 and 5, of Block E; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 35-05 E. 176.2 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way, of the C. & W. Railway; thence with the line of said right-of-way, S. 72 E, 69.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 5 and 6, of Block E; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 34-23 W. 197.2 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated May 24, 1941, and not yet recorded."
