

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE—G.R.E.M. 2

SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, --- the said **Palmetto Realty Corporation**

with interest thereon from **date** **10th day of June 1941** at the rate of **five** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid  
**in advance** until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for the holder hereof, or who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
**The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston:**  
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the West side of Belmont Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 63 on plat of McDaniel Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 47, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Belmont Avenue, joint front corner of Lots No. 62 and 63, and running thence with the West side of Belmont Avenue N. 14-30 E. 45 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Belmont Avenue, in a Northwesterly direction 28 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Belmont Avenue in a Northwesterly direction 28 feet to a point; thence with the South side of Belmont Avenue, N 89-45 W. 114 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-30 W. 49.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots No. 62 and 63; thence with the line of Lot No. 62 in a Southeasterly direction 150 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Belmont Avenue, the beginning corner.
