in the full and just sum of **Five Hundred Forty-Five and 60/100**  
(\$ **545.60**) Dollars, to be paid **one year from date, which will be due**  
**in full on July 1, 1942**

with interest thereon from **date** at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **monthly**
