for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Cedar Lane Road in gully (formerly Finley Bridge Road), and running
thence N. 3/4 E. 14.30 chains to a stake in branch; thence with land now or formerly of Riverside
Lane Company N. 57-3/4 W. 9.78 chains to stake; thence S. 3/4 W. 12.33 chains to iron pin in
