WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **Southeastern Life Insurance Company**

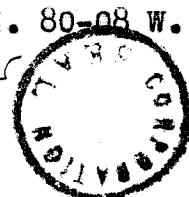
organized and existing under the laws of **South Carolina**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Thirty-nine Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$ 3900.00)**, with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum (**4½** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **Southeastern Life Insurance Company** in **Greenville, S. C.** or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Twenty-four and 69/100** Dollars (\$ **24.69**), commencing on the first day of **September**, 19 **41**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **August**, 19 **61**.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the north side of Fairview Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 of Block K on plat of Highland Terrace made by W. J. Riddle October, 1936, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book ~~24~~ page 238, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, August 14, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Fairview Avenue, joint front corner of Lots No. 11 and 12 of Block K, said pin also being 163.1 feet east from the northeast corner of the intersection of Fairview Avenue and Townes Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 12 N. 9-52 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80-08 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 10 S. 9-52 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Fairview Avenue; thence with the north side of Fairview Avenue N. 80-08 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
