WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston,

a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of **the United States of America**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Twenty-seven Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$ 2,700.00**

with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** percentum (**4½** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston (Columbia Branch) in Columbia, S. C.**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, the monthly installments of **Fifteen and 01/100** Dollars (**\$15.01**), commencing on the first day of **November** 19**41**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **October** 19**66**.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Ackley Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of Skyland Park, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 41, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, September 22, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Ackley Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 3 and 4, said pin also being 25 feet in a Southwesterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Ackley Street intersects with the Southwest side of Baker Avenue and running thence with the line of Lot No. 4, S. 25-36 E. 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of Lot No. 5 S. 64-24 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 2, N. 25-36 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Ackley Street; thence with the Southeast side of Ackley Street, N. 64-24 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The Mortgagor further agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within eight months from the date hereof (Written statement of any officer or employee of the Federal Housing Administration dated subsequent to the eight months' time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage, being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility) the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.
