For value received, I, ADRIENNE V. SCOTT, do hereby release and forever discharge the tract of land conveyed by Grover D. Altman to Charlie W. Noonan by deed dated June 12, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 235, Page 399, described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, measuring and containing two lots aggregating approximately three quarters of an acre: beginning at a black gum tree corner, on the southerly corner of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed dated November 30, 1940 and recorded in Book 229 page 227 R. M. C. office, Greenville County, January 6, 1941, and being a portion of the said tract, and from the said corner, in a generally easterly direction to a private road a distance approximately 200 feet and to an iron stake by the said road, thence in a generally northerly direction along the said private road for a distance of (150) one hundred fifty feet to another iron stake by the said road, thence in a generally westerly direction to an iron stake on the boundary line between the grantor herein and the land of W. C. Bramlett and a distance of (150) one hundred fifty feet from the beginning point on black gum tree corner and thence along the said boundary line to the black gum tree corner a distance of (150) one hundred fifty feet. Bounded on the north by other property of the grantor, on the east by a private road belonging to the grantor, on the south by other property of the grantor, and on the west by the property of W. C. 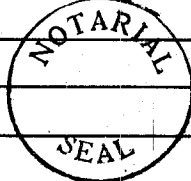
