I, **Evie V. Rector, of Greenville County, South Carolina** SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said **Evie V. Rector**

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of **Fifty and no/100**

(**\$ 50.00**) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of **Four and no/100**

(**\$ 4.00**) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said **Evie V. Rector**

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three** Dollars to me

"BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of Underwood Avenue 163.4 feet South from the Laurens Road, corner of Lot No. 55, and running thence with the line of said lot and the lines of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, N. 74-12 W. 150 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 61; thence with the line of said lot, S. 15-48 W. 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 53; thence with the line of said lot, S. 74-12 E. 150 feet to a stake on Underwood Avenue; thence with the Western side of Underwood Avenue, N. 15-48 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to Evie V. Rector by Trelena Vaughan by deed dated November 17, 1932, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "161" at Page 591.
