TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **Boyce Pittman**

SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, **I** the said **Boyce Pittman**
in and by **a** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these presents, **am**
well and truly indebted to **Piedmont Lumber Co.**

in the full and just sum of **Three Hundred Thirty Three and 25/100 dollars**
(\$ **X**) Dollars, to be paid **January 21, 1942**

with interest thereon from **date** at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **annually**

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain tract of land in Chicks Spring Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 6 miles from Greenville Court House, just off the Paris Mountain Road, containing 14 1/2 acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point 530 feet from the intersection of Buckhorn Road and the road leading up the east side of Paris Mountain, and running thence S. 38-50 W. 892.9 feet to line of Henderson property; thence with Henderson line N. 88-15 W. 915.2 feet to P. O. (down); thence N. 58-45 W. 279 feet to a stone; thence S. 79-25 W. 514.5 feet to a stone just across branch; thence N. 13.30 W. with branch to stone; thence N. 72-10 E. 845 feet to stone; thence S. 85-30 E. 976 feet; thence N. 35-10 E. 547.6 feet to stake in center of road leading up East side of Paris Mountain, and thence with said road S. 54.50 E. 200 feet to beginning corner.
