SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said H. L. Strange

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, AM well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

Two Thousand, One Hundred & No/100

(\$2,100.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

Twenty-One and No/100

(\$ 21.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said H. L. Strange

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Chick Springs Township,

and in the Town of Greer, on the East side of Earle Street (formerly Congress street), and being known and designated as Lot No. 7, of Block 3, of property of Thos. Keating, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 299, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Earle street, joint corner of Lots 7 and 8, of Block 3, which point is 58.8 feet south from the southeast corner of the intersection of Earle street with Bearden avenue (formerly Green street), and running thence along the line of Lot No. 8, in an easterly direction 193.3 feet to an iron pin; thence almost due south, 59 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 7, of Block 3; thence in a westerly direction along the joint line of Lots 6 and 7, 198.2 feet to the joint corner of said lots on the east side of Earle street; thence along the line of said Earle street in a northerly direction, 58.8 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by First National Bank, of Greenville, S. C., et al., as Executors of the Will of James Dobson deceased, by deed dated Jan. 20, 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 208, page 277."
