For and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, owner and holder of the mortgage executed by Julia Barrow Robinson to South Carolina Security Company on April 4, 1929, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 209 at page 12, securing the original sum of \$9,000, which was assigned to the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company on April 4, 1929, said assignment being recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 206, page 375, hereby releases from the lien of said mortgage the following described property, to-wit:

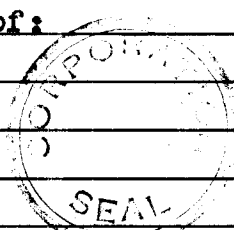
"All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the east side of McDaniel Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds, according to plat of property of Julia B. Robinson made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in February, 1935, and amended in August, 1941, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the east side of McDaniel Avenue at corner of McDaniel property, and running thence S. 63-35 E. 44 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-32 W. 42.5 feet to an iron pipe on the east side of McDaniel Avenue; thence along said east side of McDaniel Avenue N. 9-36 E. 12.7 feet to the beginning corner."

The execution and delivery hereof shall not, in any manner, effect the liens of mortgage nor its terms, in any respect, except insofar as the release of the above described land from said mortgage.
