PARTIAL RELEASE OF LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS' that for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other considerations receipt where of is hereby acknowledged, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act (Sec. 1020b, Title 12 U.S.C.), by and through The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its Agent and Attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Farm Credit Act of 1935 (sec. 1016h, Title 12 U.S.C.), does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain security instrument executed and delivered by Margaret H. Campbell, to the Land Bank Commissioner, securing the payment of the principal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), dated the 31st day of May, 1940, and recorded in the public records for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 291, at page 55, the following described property; to-wit:

One and 6/100 (1.06) acres, more or less, described on plat of survey thereof made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, November 17, 1941, and file with The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as follows: beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Augusta Road in line of Annie C. Hammond (the South line of the security) thence with the center of the road North 15 degrees 30 minutes East 960 feet, thence North 60 degrees West 9 feet to the West side of the road, thence South 19 degrees West 847 feet, thence South 12 degrees 30 minutes West 89 feet, thence South 58 degrees East 92.5 feet to the beginning.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the security of Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation as described in the security instrument hereinabove referred to shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinabove described, be preserved and protected and that the lien of said security instrument, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the note thereby secured shall remain unchanged.

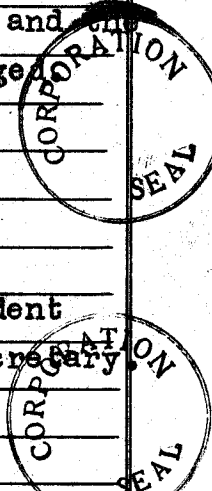

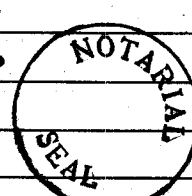
