all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the north side of Cleveland Street designated as Lot No. 14 according to a plat of McDaniel Heights recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 214, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Cleveland Street 65 feet from the southeastern intersection of Cleveland and Ben Streets joint corner of Lots No. 13 and 14, and running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 82-58 W. 175.2 feet to an iron pin in the western line of Lot No. 12; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 12 and 14, south 43.3 feet to an iron pin near joint corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 51; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 67-35 W. 164 feet to an iron pin in the line of Cleveland Street; thence along Cleveland Street N. 14-25 W. 85 feet to the point of beginning.
