 for the premium and expenses of such insurance under this mortgage, with interest.

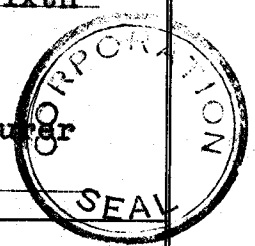
And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid, said corporation does \_\_\_\_\_
