WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

centum ($4\frac{1}{2}$ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Twenty-Two and 19/100 Dollars (\$22.19), commencing on the first day of April, 1942, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of March, 1957.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Elizabeth Drive, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 24 on plat of North Sunset Hills made by Dalton & Neves, in July 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 92, and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton February 5, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Elizabeth Drive, at joint front corner of Lots No. 24 and 25, said pin being 171 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Elizabeth Drive intersects with the Northeast side of Central Court, and running thence with the Southeast side of Elizabeth Drive, N. 63-20 E. 63 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 23 S. 26-20 E. 167.7 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the Northwest side of said strip S. 64-57 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 25 N. 27-27 W. 166.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Elizabeth Drive, the beginning corner together with a one-half interest in so much of the five-foot strip as bounds upon the above described lot on the rear.
