SEND GREETING: 143,

in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date, with these presents, are

well and truly indebted to Liberty Life Insurance Company, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of NINE THOUSAND & NO/100 (\$9,000.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at its principal office in Greenville, S. C.

as follows:

The sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to be paid on the 2nd day of October, 1942, and the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars on the 2nd days of January, April, July and October of, each year thereafter until the principal indebtedness is paid in full

with interest thereon from date and April at the rate of Five (5%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as the principal and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and fore-close this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten

per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said William D. Young and Dorothy R. Young in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Liberty Life Insurance Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to us

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on both sides of Pelham Road, about three and one-half miles east of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and containing 20.75 acres, more or less, according to a survey made by Dalton & Neve, Engineers, December, 1937, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Pelham Road, at corner of property belonging to R. F. Watson, and running thence with said Watson line, S. 17-20 W. 618 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Watson property, S. 48-20 E. 354 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-00 E. 733 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the center of Pelham Road; thence with the center of Pelham Road, S. 55-50 E. 391 feet, more or less, to a point at the intersection of Pelham Road with a county road leading in a northeasterly direction from said Pelham Road; thence with the center of said county road in a northeasterly direction, 250 feet, more or less, to a point at or near a post oak tree; thence N. 47-05 W. 896.4 feet, more or less to an iron pin, corner of Bramlett property; thence continuing with Bramlett line, N. 15-36 E. 248 feet to an iron pin and stone; thence N. 74-21 W. 215 feet to an iron pin and stone at corner of R. F. Watson property; thence with said Watson line, S. 15-33 W. 1,021 feet to an iron pin and fence post; thence continuing with said Watson property, S. 44-05 W. 270.4 feet, to an iron pin; thence still with said Watson property, S. 17-20 W. 322 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Pelham Road, the beginning corner.
