TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Ben G. Crosland, Sr. and Mary L. Crosland of
hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The Prudential Insurance Company of America, a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of New Jersey, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Thirty-eight Hundred and No/100** Dollars (\$ **3,800.00**), with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** percentum (**4½** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **The Prudential Insurance Company of America** in **Newark, New Jersey**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Twenty-four and 05/100** Dollars (\$ **24.05**), commencing on the first day of **June**, 19 **42**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **May**, 19 **62**.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of Brook Drive, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 13 on plat of property of Parrish, Gower & Martin made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book H, at page 176, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by W. J. Riddle, Engineers, April 19, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Brook Drive, the joint front corner of lots 12 and 13, said pin also being 128.1 feet South from the Southeast corner of the intersection of Brook Drive and Pearl Avenue, and running thence with the East side of Brook Drive S. 6° 56' W. 64 feet to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14; thence with the Line of Lot 14 S. 82° 22' E. 142.1 feet to an iron pin on the West side of a 15 foot alley; thence with the West side of said alley N. 00° 48' E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot 12 N. 84° 52' W. 134.6 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Brook Drive, the beginning corner.

The Mortgagor further agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within eight months from the date hereof (Written statement of any officer or employee of the Federal Housing Administration dated subsequent to the eight months time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage, being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility) the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.

The debt secured by the within mortgage has been paid in full & satisfied and the same is hereby cancelled.
