WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **The Prudential Insurance Company of America**

, a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of **the State of New Jersey**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of

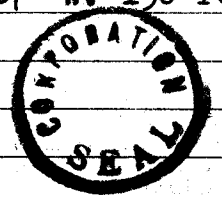
Thirty-Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$ **3,500.00**), with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum (**4½** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **The Prudential Insurance Company of America** in **Newark, N.J.**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing; in monthly installments of **Nineteen and 46/100** Dollars (\$ **19.46**), commencing on the first day of **December**, 19 **42**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **November**, 19 **67**.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 on plat of Parkview, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1942, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, at page 49, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, October, 15, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive at joint corner of Lots 5 and 6, said pin also being 275 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Morningside Drive intersects with the Northeast side of Neely Drive and running thence with the Southeast side of Morningside Drive N. 53° 43' E. 50 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence with the line of Lot 4, S. 36° 17' E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53° 43' W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 6 N. 36° 17' W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive, the beginning corner.
