being situate on the west side of Calhoun Street, in Ward Five (5) of the City of Greenville,
County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at
an iron pin on Calhoun Street, corner of lot No. 9, and running along Calhoun Street, S. 18 W.
50 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 11; thence along line of lot No. 11, N. 72 W. 198 feet to
stake; thence N. 18 E. 50 feet to corner of lot No. 9; thence along line of lot No. 9, S. 72 E.
198 feet to the beginning corner, being lot No. 10 of plat made by J. N. Southern on March 13,
1908, and recorded in Plat Book A, page 229.
