LAND BANK COMMISSIONER
AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

B. J. Odom

of Greenville County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933/hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of THIRTEEN HUNDRED FIFTY/as amended

(\$ 1350.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party,

together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum,

the first payment of interest being due and payable on the 1st day of November, 1943, and thereafter interest being

due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in Twenty (20) equal, successive, annual

installments of Sixty-seven and 50/100 (\$ 67.50) Dollars each, and a final install-

ment of (\$ -) Dollars, the first installment of

said principal being due and payable on the 1st day of November, 1943, and thereafter the remaining installments of

principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms,

conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to

second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum

of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party,

his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that certain tract of land containing Forty (40) acres, more or less, formerly known as the

"Jane D. Wilson property", in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about 9 miles

North from the Town of Greer, on the old Gap Creek Road and near Lenoah School, and now in the

possession of B. J. Odom, BOUNDED on the North by lands of Fred Sudduth; on the East by lands

of Fred Sudduth; on the South by lands of C. O. Brown; and on the West by lands of B. L. Sudduth

and H. E. Fowler. Said tract of land is particularly shown and delineated on a plat prepared

by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, in August, 1942, which is recorded in Plat Book N at page 31, in the

office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance of Greenville County, South Carolina, which plat and

the record thereof are by reference incorporated herein.

The debt secured by the within instrument having been paid in full, said instrument is hereby satisfied and cancelled and the lien thereof discharged. This the 26th day of March 1954.
