with the buildings and improvements thereon, on the north side of McIver Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 95 on plat of property of the R. B. R. Land and Development Company, said plat being recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 20, said lot being more particularly described as follows:
