until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, bounded on the north by lands of J. C. Rushton and Bishop, on the east by property of L. H. Thompson, on the south by G. P. Stanley and Thompson and on the west by G. P. Stanley with metes and bounds to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin near south side of branch, corner of Bishop lands and running thence N. 66-30 W. 529 feet to flint rock north of branch; thence S. 5-45 W. 350 feet to stone; Rushton corner; thence further along Rushton line N. 88-30 W. 718 feet to stone, Stanley corner (formerly owned by G. W. Stone); thence S. 5-07 W. 604 feet to a stone; thence continuing along Stanley line S. 89-45 E. 723 feet to a stone; Thompson corner; thence N. 77-30 E. 523 feet to iron pin; thence further along Thompson line N. 5-35 E. 612 feet to the beginning corner, containing 18.88 acres, more or less, according to plat of survey made by W.
