Adams, Engineer, on or about December 15, 1937, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, according to said Plat:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of the Scuffletown Road, which point is 445 feet East of the Southeastern intersection of the Scuffletown Road with an unnamed 15 foot road; thence along the Scuffletown Road S. 83-30 E. 195.1 feet to a point; Southwestern intersection of Scuffletown Road with an unnamed Road; running thence along said unnamed Road S. 14-42 E. 341.5 feet to a point; running thence along rear line of Tract No. "C" N. 83-30 W. 195.1 feet to a point, joint Southern corner of Tracts No. C and B; running thence along dividing line of Tracts B and C, N. 14-42 W. 341.5 feet to the beginning corner on Scuffletown Road, containing 1.5 acres, more or less.
