"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

In Greenville Township, on the Southern side of Arlington Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of Property of P. F. Cox Estate, made by W. A. Adams, February 2, 1917, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book E at page 66, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Arlington Avenue, 90 feet West from Green Avenue, and running thence S. 28 1/2 W. 157 feet to a stake; thence in a Westerly direction 59.5 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of said lot in a Northerly direction 161 feet to Arlington Avenue; thence with the Southern side of Arlington Avenue S. 70 1/2 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to E. W. Pike by Vashti Cox DeVane by deed dated May 22, 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Book of Deeds 87 at page 570.
