WHEREAS I, Annie P. Chandler

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100

Five (5%) Dollars, with interest at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FIFTEEN AND NO/100 (\$ 15.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Annie P. Chandler

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me Annie P. Chandler

the said Annie P. Chandler in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, on the east side of Vannoy Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 33, of Section H, of the Stone Land Company property, and having, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at pages 337 and 345, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Vannoy street, joint corner of Lots 31 and 33, which point is approximately 230 feet south of the southeast intersection of Stone avenue and Vannoy street, and running thence along the line of Lot 31, S. 71-20 E. 217 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 19-20 W. 55 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 33 and 35; thence along the line of said lots, N. 71-20 W. 217 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Vannoy street; thence along the line of said Vannoy street, N. 19-20 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Piedmont Lumber Company by deed dated Oct. 11, 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 72, page 347."
