Dollars on the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the provisions of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, be immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fees and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, on the west side of Rowley street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, 317 feet from the northwest corner of Carrier street now East Park Avenue and Rowley street, and running thence with Rowley street, N. 20-19 E. 58 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77 W. 207 feet 9 1/2 inches to an iron pin on an 18-foot alley; thence along the line of said alley, S. 20-19 W. 58 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77 E. 206 1/2 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
