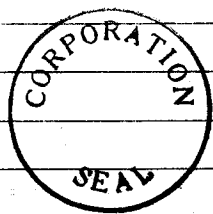
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the South side of Long Hill Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 86 on plat of Augusta Road Hills made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at pages 56 and 57, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May 28th, 1943, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Long Hill Street, at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 85 and 86, said pin also being 861.3 feet West from the Southwest corner of the intersection of Long Hill Street and Henrietta Avenue and running thence with the line of Lot No. 85, S. 2-56 W. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-04 W. 38.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 89-20 W. 21.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 87, N. 2-56 E. 161.3 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Long Hill Street; thence with the South side of Long Hill Street, S. 87-04 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
