I, Genevieve K. Bull, of Greenville County, this 11th day of April 1944, FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION, SECRETARY-TREASURER, BY M. M. Russell, ATTORNEY AT LAW, WITNESSES: Bettie West Dalphin, Margaret A. Means SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said Genevieve K. Bull in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of

Four Thousand and no/100 (\$4,000.00) Dollars, five (5%)

with interest at the rate of 5% per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Thirty-One and 64/100

(\$ 31.64) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest as herein provided; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; and no further provision that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall be due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Genevieve K. Bull

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

the said Genevieve K. Bull in hand well and truly paid by FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of S. C., on Prentiss Avenue, and being known and designated as lot No. 1 of Block K, of the O. P. Mills property; said plat being recorded in Plat Book "F", at page 171 and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Prentiss Avenue, corner of lot No. 2, and running thence with line of lot No. 2, S. 44-33 E. 143.5 ft. to an iron pin on Mission Street; thence with Mission Street N. 7-25 E. 36 ft. to iron pin on said street; thence N. 9-53 E. 78.5 ft.; thence continuing with curve of said street 73.9 ft; thence continuing with said street N. 44-33 W. 10 feet to corner of Prentiss Avenue and Mission Street; thence with Prentiss Avenue S. 45-27 W. 126 ft. to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to mortgagor by Irene V.
