(\$4,800.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments

Said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal. Said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing that ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

Woodside, and running thence along the center of the Old Augusta Road, S. 74-17 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said road, S. 20-50 W. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said road, S. 10-0 W. 163 feet to an iron pin, being the joint corner of the property now or formerly belonging to W. R. Lupo and this lot; thence along the line of the Lupo lot, N. 80-35 E. 290.8 feet to an iron pin on the new Augusta Road; thence along the west side of the Augusta Road, N. 13-13 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to us by J. Foster Lupo, as Trustee by deed not yet recorded."
