Marston, Number 2,

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the McGaha property as shown on a plat recorded in Plat book "F" at page 33, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
