I, Hazel Mary Sloan, of Greenville County, S. C.,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said Hazel Mary Sloan

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to  
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of ONE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED &  
NO/100

(\$ 1,700.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of SEVENTEEN AND NO/100  
(\$ 17.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Hazel Mary Sloan, the said

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said Hazel Mary Sloan

C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 68 on plat of a subdivision known as Oakwood, and having, according to plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 424, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Henry street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 68 and 69, which point is 185 feet from the intersection of Goldsmith street and Henry street, and running thence with the line of Henry street, N. 41-30 W. 61 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 67 and 68; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 48-30 E. 183 feet to an iron pin on a 14-foot alley; thence along the line of said 14-foot alley, S. 41-30 E. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-30 W. 183 feet to an iron pin on Henry street, the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to Mrs. F. L. Tillotson by deed dated April 25, 1911, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 11, page 475, and in which Josephine White inherited an undivided one-third interest and purchased the other undivided two-thirds interest from Ben R. Tillotson and Pearle T. Scott, by deed dated Oct. 28, 1936 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 186 at page 134."

Being also the same lot of land conveyed to me by Nell W. Chreitzberg by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded, this mortgage being given to secure the unpaid portion of the purchase price thereof.
