All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing 29 acres more or less located about 6 miles from the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the White Horse Road and being the same conveyed to R. E. Griffin by Twettie Fleming on May 22, 1943 by a deed recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville in book 253, page 436 and is more specifically described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the Whitehorse road and running thence N. 71 E. 20.46 to a stake; thence N. 16 W. 13.50 to a post oak stump; thence S. 86 1/4 W. 17.00 to a stake on the Whitehorse Road; thence along said road as the line 18.50 to the beginning corner.
