all that tract or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the Congaree (Settlement) Road, about  $5\frac{1}{4}$  Miles from Greenville, S. C., containing six (6) acres, more or less, with the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in Congaree Road, thence along same S.  $51\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.75 to a bend in said Road; thence S.  $48\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.00 to a bend; thence S. 53 E. 7.50 to a stone; thence S.  $56\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.23 to an iron pin; thence N.  $44\frac{1}{2}$  E. 1.86 to a stake on P. O.; thence N.  $44\frac{1}{2}$  W. 17.40 to an iron pin; thence S.  $44\frac{1}{2}$  W. 4.35 to the beginning, bounded by lands of E. M. Cole, Warren Green, Walter Green, being the same conveyed to the said John Turner by Mrs. Emily M. Cole by her deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Deeds, Volume 28, at page 511.
