Office for Greenville County, Plat Book C, Page 199, being approximately 70 ft. on the Paris Mountain Road and extending back 160.9 ft. more or less, together with all rights and easements that I may now have or hereafter attain to the new cut road.

ALSO: Just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville on David Street and described as follows: BEGINNING at corner of lot of J. B. Beavers on David Street, and running thence with David Street N. 23 1/2 W. 43-1/3 feet to corner of C. I.
