with interest thereon from date semi-annually per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent. of the amount due thereon

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee his Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece and parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in

Bates Township, Greenville containing 23 3/4 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake in the road and running thence N. 30 W. 4.50 chs. to a stake in the road; thence N. 12 1/2 W. 7.50 chs. to stake in the road; thence N. 70 1/2 W. 12.40 chs. to a stake in the Greenville Road; thence S. 21 W. 18.94 chs. with the last named road to a stake; thence N. 84 E. 23.00 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of J.
