well and truly indebted to Mrs. J. H. Alewine, G. W. Alewine and Ansel Alewine, partners trading
as Taylors Lumber Company
in the full and just sum of EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100
(\$ 850.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near Brushy Creek Baptist Church, lying on the Northern side of the upper Greer-Brushy Creek Road, being bounded on the Northeastern side by the tract conveyed to Hovie Edens, et al, on the Southeastern and South by said road, Brushy Creek cemetery grounds, Brushy Creek School lot, and on the West by lands of Mrs. Frank James, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the Southern shoulder of the said Greer-Brushy Creek Road, joint corner of tract conveyed to Hovie Edens, and runs thence with the dividing line of the Edens tract and this tract N. 50-35 W. 1294 feet to an iron pin on the line of Mrs. Frank James; thence with the James line S. 10-30 E. 1015 feet to an iron pin in the old road bed; thence S. 84-45 E. 48.5 feet to an iron pin, school lot corner; thence with the school lot line N. 25-00 E. 158.5 feet to a stone, old corner; thence S. 78-45 E. 132 feet to a stone near a Hickory Tree, school lot corner; thence S. 12-15 W. 132 feet to a Flint stone corner in school yard, school corner; thence S. 85-30 E. 253 feet to a stake on the Southern Shoulder of the above named road, church lot corner; thence N. 58-30 E. 299 feet to a point in the Southern ditch (stone on bank) Church cemetery lot corner; thence with the road N. 56-00 E. 101 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 10.50 acres, more or less.
