in the Sandy Flat section about twelve miles from Greenville Courthouse just off the Sandy Flat and Locust Hill Road and bounded by lands of Doff Moon, R. A. Craft, Styles and others being all of the one hundred acres of land which was conveyed to my father, Moses E. Moon by Moses E. Moon and Gideon Moon, Executors of the estate of R. W. Moon by deed dated December 3, 1906, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Deed Book TTT, page 159, except 18.01 acres sold by my father to Homer Styles by deed recorded in Deed Book 228, at page 307 and ten acres sold by the widow and children of said Moses E. Moon to R. A. Craft by deed recorded in Deed Book 262, page 165. Said tract of land herein mortgaged contains 89 acres, more or less according to a survey by W. P.
