(\$ 3,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of THIRTY AND NO/100

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Augusta Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 67 and 68 which point is 60 feet from the southeast corner of the intersection of Augusta Road and Douglass Drive, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 60-47 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots in the line of Lot No. 66; thence along the line of said Lot No. 66, S. 29-13 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 69 and 70; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 60-47 W. 150 feet to the joint corner of said lots on Augusta Road; thence along the line of said Augusta Road, N. 29-13 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
